






The Sarasota Opera House (originally the A.B. Edwards Theater) is an historic theater, now opera house, located at 61 North Pineapple Avenue in Sarasota, Florida. The building was the vision of A.B. Edwards, the first mayor of Sarasota. It opened on April 10, 1926, with a three-story entrance containing eight shops on the ground floor, 12 offices on the second floor, and 12 furnished apartments on the third, while the theatre's auditorium housed an orchestral pipe organ. As noted on the Sarasota Opera's website, the Sarasota Herald Tribune hailed Edwards for "having admitted Sarasota into a fairyland of costly decoration, rich furnishings and never to be forgotten artistry".

The building was designed by Roy A. Benjamin in the Mediterranean Revival style of the era and was built by the GA Miller Construction Company.

The theater is the home of the Sarasota Opera Association, Inc., which owns the building. The Association is the parent body that runs the Sarasota Opera.

The house contains 1,119 seats.

Jerry Harrison and Adrian Belew REMAIN IN LIGHT

Talking Heads guitarist, Jerry Harrison, and Grammy-nominated musician, Adrian Belew, are kick-starting this year's RoSFest on Friday, April 15 with members of the currently disbanded New York City funk group, Turkuaz, as their backing band.

Talking Heads' fourth album, *Remain In Light* was the most inventive of their albums, incorporating funky guitar and keyboard sounds and African polyrhythms which solidified their signature sound, and delivered the singles 'Once In A Lifetime' and 'Houses In Motion'.

Harrison was originally a member of the rock band, The Modern Lovers, before joining Talking Heads and has produced albums for bands No Doubt, Crash Test Dummies, and Live (to name but a few). He met up with Belew in 2019 to discuss his idea of recreating the *Remain In Light* live show to celebrate the 40th anniversary of the record's release.

Belew, whose immense resume includes singing and playing guitar with King Crimson, touring extensively with artists such as David Bowie, Frank Zappa, and Paul Simon, not to mention releasing 20 solo albums of his own, performed on the album and joined Talking Heads on the original tour. After discussing the plan to take the album back out on the road with Harrison, Belew stated, "I felt the world needed this joyful, danceable kind of upbeat thing that's still real cool."

In addition to performing songs off *Remain In Light*, the RoSFest performance will feature other songs from the Talking Heads repertoire, as well as songs from Harrison and Belew's other groups, such as King Crimson and The Modern Lovers.

Lobate Scarp's twist on Progressive Rock music takes the listener on a unique musical journey. The band's debut album *Time and Space* was described as "one of the top 13 albums of 2013" by the online blog, Progarchy. Recording of the album had been made possible by a successful Kickstarter campaign in 2012 and the end result received accolades from all over the world. This was followed up by the EP *Spirals and Portals* released in 2019. Similar in fashion, the tracks were engineered/produced by Steven Leavitt and co-produced, partially recorded and mixed by Rich Mouser (Transatlantic, Neal Morse, Spock's Beard). The band is currently working on an ambitious second full-length album, entitled *You Have It All*.

While their studio albums consist of a plethora of special guests, an array of orchestral instruments, and maybe even the occasional choir singing in Latin, the more contained, yet still mighty, live rendition of Scarp is harnessed by vocalist/keyboardist Adam Sears, bassist Andy Catt, guitarist Peter Matuchniak, and drummer Lance Crane.

Palm Avenue Garage (City of Sarasota)

Located northwest of the Palm Avenue and Main Street intersection, just behind the Opera House. The first 2 hours are complimentary, after which there is a \$3 charge for hour 3, and \$1 for each hour thereafter. For easy exit, pay before you return to your car. Plaza at Five Points Located at 50 Central Avenue: entrance on 1st Street. \$2 per hour, up to \$6 maximum. 100 Central Avenue Entrance on 2nd Street. Important Note

Please do not park in the parking lot of the William G. Selby Library or in the ground floor lot adjacent to the Whole Foods Market, as you may be towed and/or ticketed. Beginning January 2020, the Selby Library will be open on Sundays and opera patrons who park there may be towed.



TENJINN

Neo-classical/progressive rock band, Ten Jinn, was formed in 1991 by John Paul Strauss and Jimmy Borel. Their first CD, *Wildman*, was recorded over the next couple of years and was finally released in 1996. This was followed up in 1999 by their second album *As On A Darkling Plain*. In 2001, the band was back in the studio recording tracks for their third album *Alone*, released on Sweden Rock Records in 2003. The band's fourth release (2018) was a reworking of a symphonic poem, *Sisyphus*, which Strauss had originally composed for piano and string orchestra as part of his Masters of Music degree in theory and composition. May 2018 also saw the release of Ten Jinn's fifth studio album *Ziggy Blackstar: A Tribute to David Bowie*.

In February 2020 the band began writing material for its sixth album, *Ardis* (a concept inspired by Jack London's 1907 novel, *The Iron Heel*). Work on the album and rehearsals for live shows came to an abrupt halt, however, at the end of February 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Whilst working on *Ardis* Straus also drafted what should become the band's seventh release, *Worlds: the Four Worlds of the Hopi* (a 60-minute piece in four movements inspired by the Hopi creation mythology/cosmology stories).

MARTIN SPRINGETT

Martin has been an illustrator of fantasy book covers and children's picture books since 1984, when he illustrated the covers for Guy Gavriel Kay's classic fantasy trilogy, The Fionavar Tapestry. Martin's Fionavar covers were published worldwide and are still in print.

He has won the Aurora Award for fantasy illustration, the Ruth Schwartz Award in the children's picture book field for The Nightwalker, and was nominated for the Governor Generals Award for his illustrations in Richard Thompson's book, Who. Other book titles featuring Martin's illustrations include Mei Ming and The Dragon's Daughter, The Follower, and Too Many Suns.

As a writer, Martin authored and illustrated his first book, Jousting with Jesters in 2006.

In 2011, Fitzhenry and Whiteside published his Breakfast on a Dragon's Tail: And Other Book Bites while Kate & Pippin: An Unlikely Friendship (2012), written by Martin and featuring photographs by his sister, Isobel, has won numerous accolades including The Blue Spruce award.

As a musician, Martin recorded his first album in 1969; Under the Mountain is a setting of J R R Tolkien's poems from Lord of the Rings and The Hobbit. As the founding member of The Gardening Club, he has released six albums under that name plus four solo albums.

2022 RoSFest Illustrator



Robert Berry's 32°

Guitarist, vocalist, and record producer Robert Berry, has made a lot of outstanding music, both prog and otherwise, over the years. Most notably he teamed up with Carl Palmer and Keith Emerson in 1987 to form the band 3 which released its album *To The Power Of Three* the following year.

Years later, in 2015, having participated in numerous projects following the disbandment of 3, Berry again joined forces with Keith Emerson, this time with the intention of making a follow-up to the 1988 album. Unfortunately, the project was shelved following the tragic death of Emerson in March 2016. Eventually, Berry went on to complete the album on his own. Entitled *The Rules Have Changed*, it was finally released in 2018 under the moniker 3.2. This was followed up in 2021 by the release of *Third Impression*, which ends with the superb track, 'Never', the last song Berry wrote with Keith Emerson.

The 3.2 live line-up features Robert Berry on bass and lead vocals, Paul Keller on guitars, Andrew Colyer on keyboards, and Jimmy Keegan on drums.

Enjoy a cool drink with friends while listening to some cool music from our musical minstrel friends between all scheduled performances throughout the festival weekend.





Jon Anderson with the Paul Green Rock Academy

The motto "Music. Culture. Community" represents the foundations on which RoSFest is built and this year's Saturday night headlining act was specifically chosen to epitomise just what the festival stands for by bringing together the past, present and future of music in a single performance. Jon Anderson, a rock legend in his own right, with a career spanning over four decades, is joined on stage by young and highly-talented musicians from the Paul Green Rock Academy.

Jon Anderson requires little introduction, a founding member of Yes his entire discography includes numerous solo albums and collaborations with a whole array of artists making him one of the most prolific musicians of our time. His 15th studio album released in 2019 and aptly titled '1000 Hands' due to the numerous guest appearances that went into its creation, embodies a musical journey like no other.

The Rock Academy on the other hand is a "rock school dedicated to serious musicians" founded by American record producer, film producer, director, screenwriter, singer-songwriter, music teacher, entrepreneur, and philanthropist, Paul Green. Students aged 10-18 are selected based on their dedication to music, showmanship, love of performing, and ability to rock with actual pros.

Jon Anderson's collaboration with the Academy dates back to 2005.

HEAD WITH WINGS

Head with Wings is an emotionally evocative force in the world of modern progressive rock. They're a band that rides the line between the conceptually ambitious art-rock of the 70s and the more immediate alternative rock of the late 90s/early 2000s.

On their current EP, Comfort In Illusion, Head with Wings draws the listener into an isolated, agonizing, and momentarily euphoric struggle for self-actualization amidst the stifling frame of an increasingly unfamiliar world.

The Prog Space (UK) had this to say of the new EP: "Bands in 10/20 years from now will be citing Head with Wings as their influence, in much the same way as early Genesis, Rush and Yes are mentioned amongst their peers today".

The DPRP (NL) went on to say:

"They have their own style of modern progressive rock and they exploit those abilities of blending alternative rock choruses with odd structures and arrangements, without losing the emotive vibes of the compositions".

In recent years, Head with Wings won an Independent Music Award for "Best Rock Song" with 'Goodbye Sky'. They then went on to tour Germany and play the Euroblast Festival. Presently, the band is in the middle of producing their upcoming sophomore album, slated for release later in 2022.

THE TEA CLUB

The Tea Club is a band about feeling. Their music is earnest and impassioned, combining elements of art-rock, folk, electronica, and romanticism to create a distinctive sound that's all their own.

The band is fronted by the song-writing team of brothers, Patrick and Dan McGowan, whose unorthodox guitar playing and fervent singing form the core of the group's unique style. Bassist Jamie Wolff, keyboardist Joe Dorsey, and drummer Dan Monda complete the ensemble.

Pattern-Seeking Animals is a California-based progressive/art-rock group formed in 2018 by Ted Leonard, Dave Meros, John Boegehold and Jimmy Keegan, all of whom are current and former members and collaborators of progressive rock band Spock's Beard.

As John Boegehold explains, "Originally P-SA was intended to be a recording project but as the debut album started coming together, we began talking seriously about doing it as a live band."

Said debut album, the critically-acclaimed eponymous *Pattern-Seeking Animals*, was released in 2019 and less than a year later was followed up by *Prehensile Tales* (2020) described as "a continuation of that magic whose blend of top-notch songwriting and seductively eccentric but welcoming scores are damn near faultless".

The band has recently released its third album *Only Passing Through* and their performance at RoSFest to promote their latest offering is just one in a series of the band's first-ever live shows.
